Main Barn - The primary building acting as the Inn, opened in 1985 by Al & Beth Granger who purchased the original 16-acre farm that had been abandoned for 13 years following the death of the previous owner, William Kirschner. At that time, the Main Barn functioned as both the Granger family home, guest accommodations, restaurant and reception desk. While the Granger's home was later moved to another location on the property, the rest of the Main Barn remains the same.

Gatehouse, Garden Cottage & Carriage House - With the caring touch of master carpenters, the original tractor shed became the Carriage House, another shed became the Gate House and the Garden Cottage was made ready for guests.

Farmhouse - Initially a single-family home the Farmhouse was renovated into guest rooms after residents relocated to another town.

Stables - Though not original to Glasbern, the Stables were once located on a nearby farm. The entire structure was dismantled, moved and then re-assembled into guest rooms.

Packhouse - The Packhouse has a similar history, two dilapidated barns on a nearby farm were dismantled and rebuilt on Glasbern to form one large building of twelve guestrooms.

Spa & Fitness Center - The Grangers built this as their home and remodeled the lower level to accommodate spa services. Today, the Spa now occupies the main floor of the building and has been upgraded with new equipment.

The Dairy - Once a working dairy used to raise dairy cattle for the purpose of making cheese and yogurt for resale. Recently, the Dairy was transformed combining rustic charm with modern conveniences, into a six-bedroom rental house enjoyed by wedding parties and corporate groups.

Glasloft - This space has historically been the open-air patio of the Main Barn. It was recently enclosed and, its stunning views overlooking one of Glasbern's pristine ponds, quickly made it a favorite venue for weddings and events.

Grand Lodge - Originally a tented outdoor event space, the Grand Lodge was enclosed in 2013. It now features 20-foot-high ceilings with exposed beams, a stone fireplace and a private patio overlooking a tranquil pond and lush gardens.

Wedding Pavilion/Pickleball Court - A dual purpose venue built for the previous owner's wife who enjoyed the sport and also a popular wedding venue with beautiful scenic overlooks of the pond and hand-crafted rock garden.
